

**Service Learning and Student Performance in Basic Statistics Courses:  
Further Evidence**

**ABSTRACT**

The difference in academic performance between service learning students and non-service learning students was examined in this study. Test scores for the first and second semesters were compared between the service learning and non service-learning students. A significant difference was found in academic performance between service learning and non-service learning students. Students who participated in the service learning projects showed greater performance than the students who did not participate in the service learning projects. Therefore, this study demonstrated that a service-learning project is more effective than non-service learning projects for Basic Statistics performance.
